## NB Marconi Towers

There's an effort underway to save some of Marconi's original towers, and an online poll is open for people to vote on it being a restoration project through the "Next Great Save" project from the National Trust for Canada. Some of Marconi's first messages were received and transmitted using the Battle Harbour Marconi Towers, thought to be the last of their kind standing in North America. News of Admiral Robert Peary's 1909 North Pole expedition was transmitted by these towers. After 100 years, the twin towers are in need of repair. See the above website for picture and details.
